



Video of your training

Training has a tendency to be approached in a “follow a recipe” type format. But its not that simple. First you have to learn what to do with different parts of your body and when to do those things. On top of that both you and your dog are unique individuals and what works for one team may be completely wrong for another team. It is not as formulaic as it may appear and it is a step by step process. Some training exercises have 3-10 steps that need to be mastered before you are done with training the behavior. Ideally, I would be able to watch and help you every time you train. But that would be cost prohibitive.

The Solution

The solution to these problems is for your to send me short 1 minute videos of each training exercise **every couple of days**.

In addition, you can watch the videotapes of your training to allow you to study your dog carefully and to be sure that what you are doing is helping. This class is dedicated to building your relationship as well as your skills. The camera will show you so much that you do not see in the moment.

Look at your dog’s attitude as well as its skill! With time, are we building a joy for the training process?

Videotape and review your work regularly if possible. Let the camera show you things you didn't notice. Is your dog engaged with you and your game? Is he relaxed and eager to play with you? Did you get the order of events right on the training game?

The camera sees a lot. **Just send me 1 minute clips.**

These video's are critical to your success.

They allow me to:
tweak the training between classes, giving you the most bang for your buck
compare different aspects your dog’s learning

Ways to record your training sessions

Use a tripod or prop up your phone or ipad or camcorder and record a typical training session. Or Have your recording devise low enough and close enough to capture everything you are doing without you going out of the frame.

If you are recording session with a smart phone or ipad, do an internet search for ipad or iphone tripod. Is that a tool that will help you?




Step 1. From the Ipad, Iphone or Smart phone you shot your video from

Ipad, Iphone

1. Open a new e-mail
2. Type in **your** e-mail address and subject line.
3. In the text part of the e-mail type any messages you wish to send me
4. Double-tap where you'd like to insert the video. A menu will appear. It will say Select, Select all and have an arrow.
5. Tap the arrow to view more options.
6. Tap Insert Photo or Video. You'll be taken to your Photos - select the Camera Roll
7. Select the video you'd like to insert.
8. You'll see a Preview of the image.
9. Tap on Choose (at the bottom) to confirm it's the right one.
8. Tap the Send button in the upper right corner.
