6 Ways to Dare to Coach

1

Change your coaching self-image

Don't think of yourself as "one more thing."
What value do you add to teaching?

2

Listen beyond frustration & complaints

Listen to understand and avoid defensiveness.

3

Be the resource they need

Figure out what teachers need, and do it. Small wins go far.

4

Be the liaison to administration

Administrators can lose sight of what teaching looks like. Be the voice that speaks for the teachers.

5

Make every meeting purposeful

Meeting should result in something useful for teachers.

6

Turn those complaints into goals

Complaints are cries for help. Use them to create purpose in your work together.
