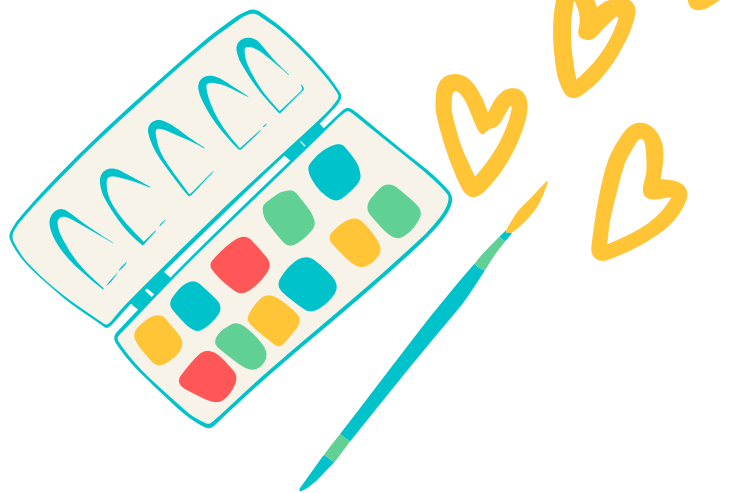


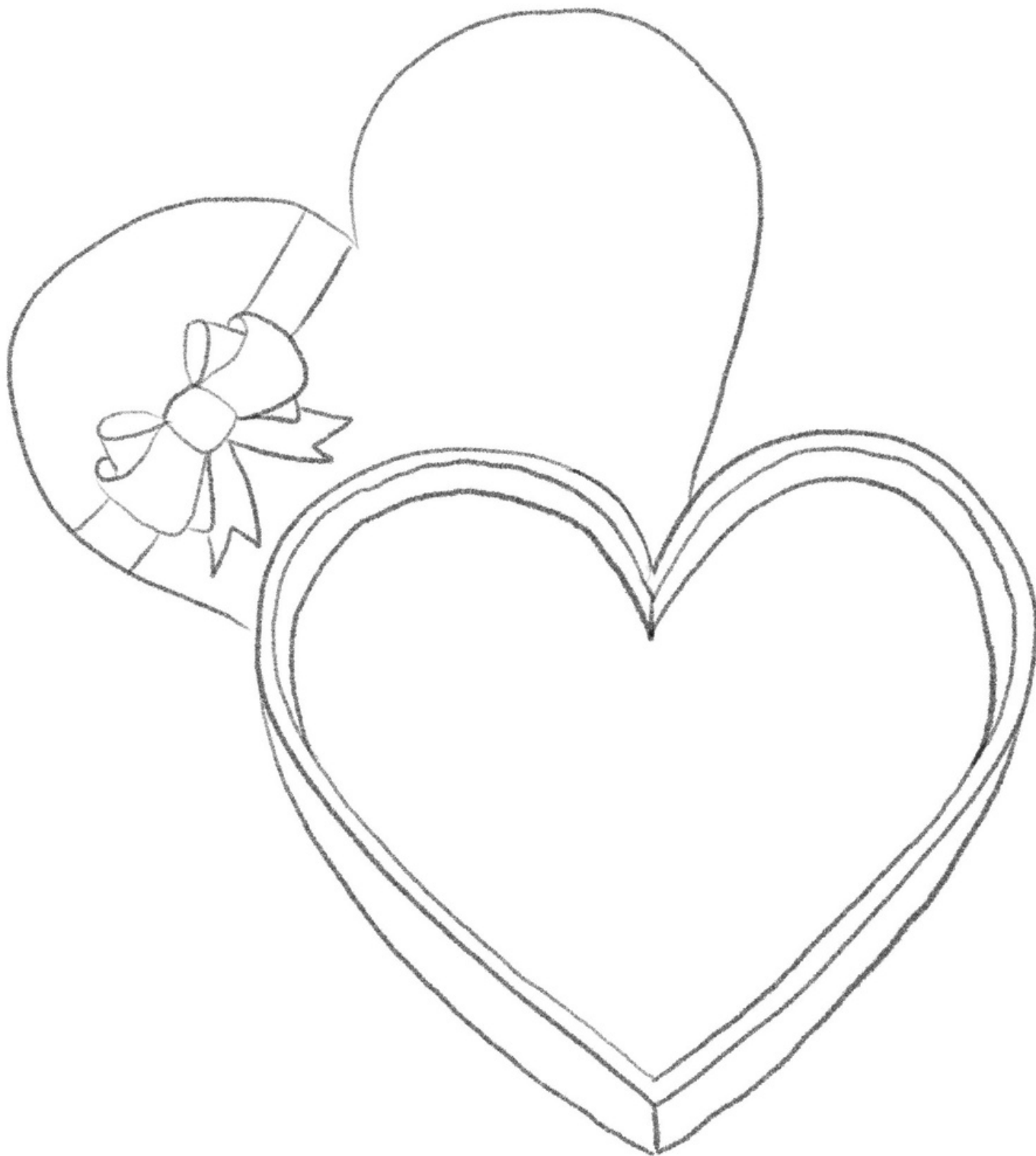

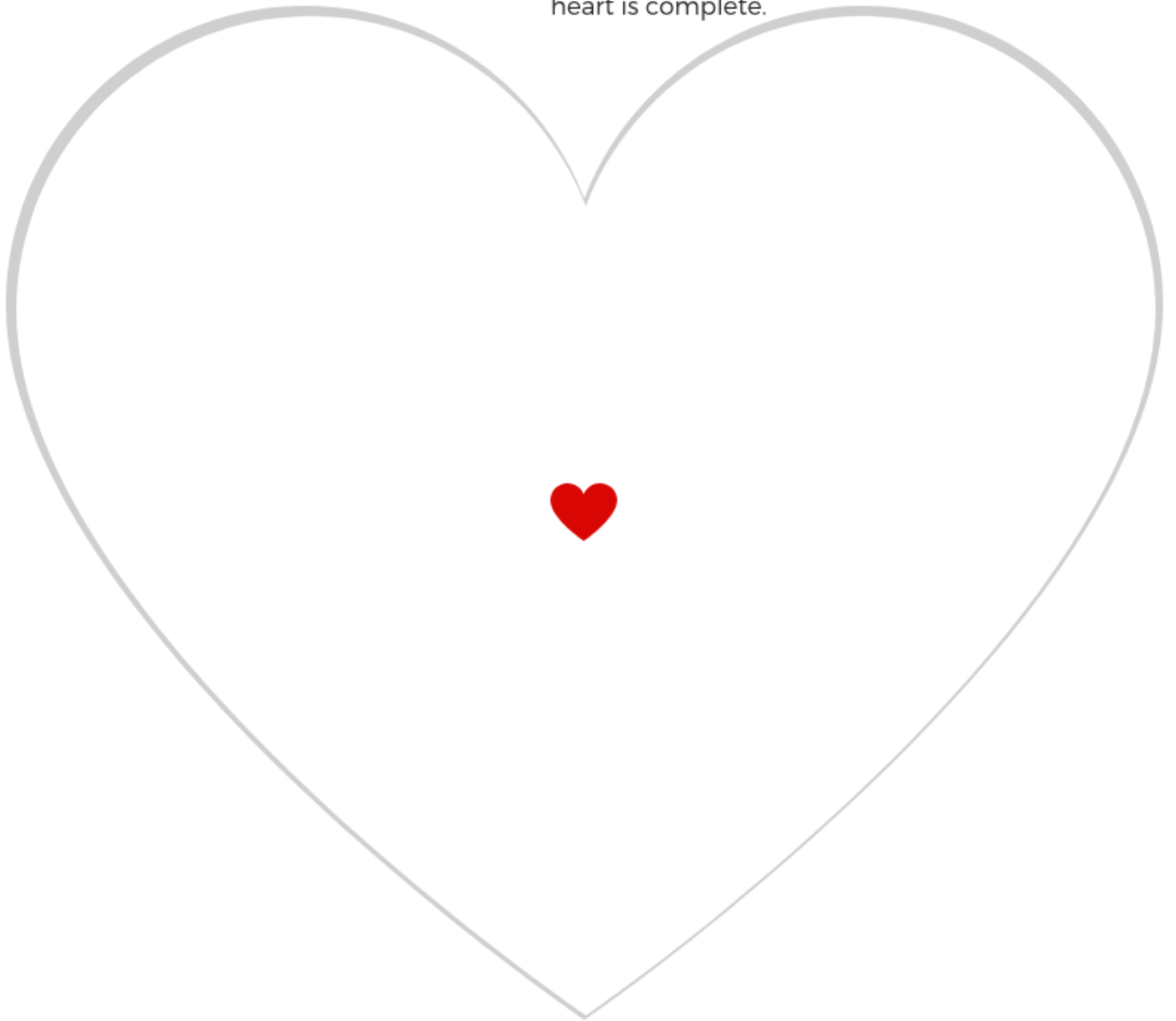


## Box of Chocolates

# Back and Forth Heart Mandala

- 1.** Person 1 adds a layer around the center heart with another heart or design element.
- 2.** Person 2 adds a layer around that heart/design with a different color.
- 3.** Continue back & forth until both decide the heart is complete.



# Salt "Puffy" Paint



*This homemade "puffy" paint is easy to make with simple kitchen ingredients. Use squeeze bottles to paint with it, and a toothpick to swirl the colors together if you like.*

## MATERIALS

- ☐ 1 cup salt
- ☐ 1 cup flour
- ☐ 1 cup water
- ☐ 1 Tbsp tempera paint per color desired
- ☐ Cardboard
- ☐ Squeeze bottles\*
- ☐ Toothpicks (optional)

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Mix the salt, flour, and water together in a medium bowl.
2. Divide the puffy paint mixture between squeeze bottles.
3. Add a different color tempera paint to each squeeze bottle and stir with a chopstick or spoon. Screw the lid back on.
4. Squeeze your puffy paint onto the cardboard to make a design or picture. Try hearts, snowflakes, or faces. If you like, use a toothpick to drag one color into another or swirl the colors together for a marbled effect.
5. Let the paint dry completely (2-3 days) into hard, sparkly three-dimensional artworks.

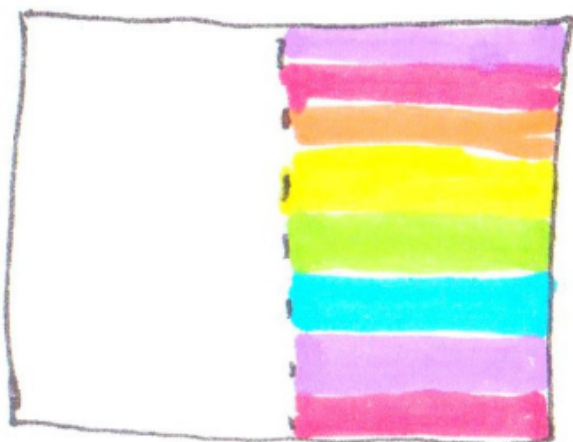
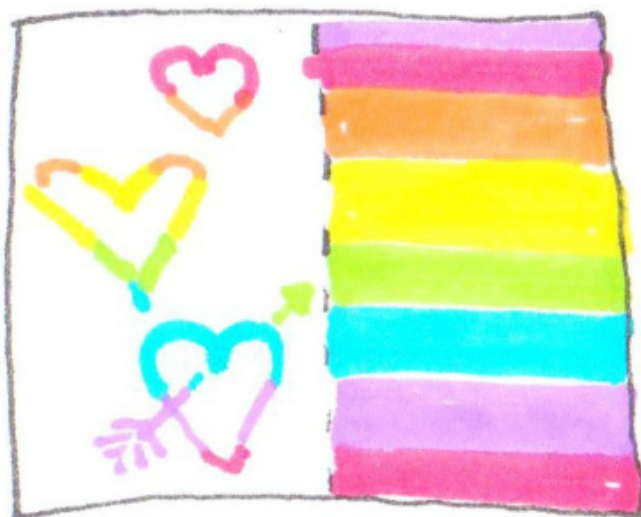
*\*You can purchase inexpensive squeeze bottles in the hair or beauty section of a drug store or grocery store. Or you can reuse squeeze bottles that you already have around the house (such as ketchup or shampoo bottles)*

# Rainbow Hearts

*Your kids are going to love this one.

## MATERIALS

- White Paper
- Crayons or oil pastels
- Pencil



## INSTRUCTIONS

- Fill half a sheet of paper with a rainbow of crayon or oil pastel.
- Fold the paper in half with the crayon layer on the inside.
- Use a pencil to draw hearts (or any picture) on the outside, pressing hard.
- Open the paper to reveal your rainbow hearts.
