Other guidelines

- Do not place items in a plastic bag unless explicitly requested.
- Always make sure solid and liquid food is removed and rinse the item.
- Keep paper and cardboard dry and clean,
- Tear up large boxes.
- Do not overfill your bin to avoid spillage during collection
