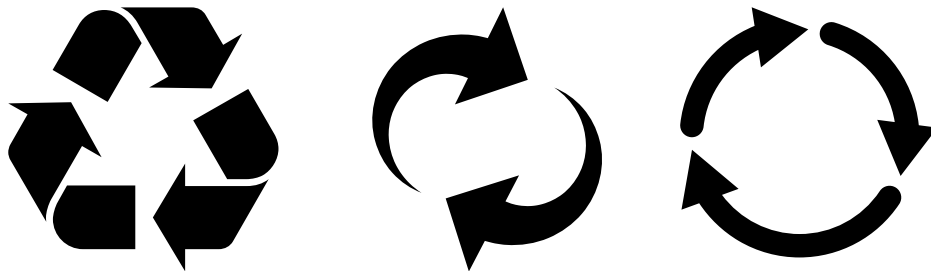


Recycling Labels

Take care when using labels to decide if an item is recyclable and always check your local rules.

LABELS YOU CAN'T RELY ON

Recyclability depends on local rules so these labels are too general and cannot be trusted to inform you if an item is recyclable.

LABELS WITH DIFFERENT MEANINGS

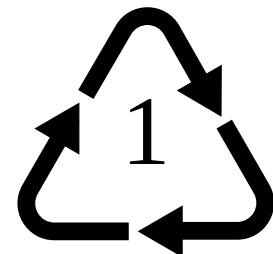
These labels are commonly mistaken for recycling labels but have a different meaning.



Tidy man symbol - don't litter



Labels that refer to the presence of recycled content



Plastic Resin Identification codes - type of plastic

LABELS TO LOOK FOR

Advanced recycling labels provide loads of information on how to recycle. This example is for Australia & New Zealand by Australasian Recycling Label (ARL). However, always check your local rules.

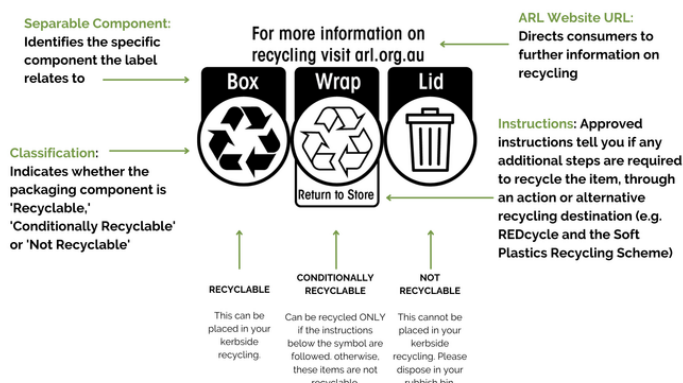
