Egg 1	Cracker	While they were eating, Jesus took a loaf of bread, and after blessing it he broke it, gave it to the disciples, and said, "Take, eat; this is my body." Matthew 26:26 (NRSV)
Egg 2	Silver Coin	Then one of the twelve, who was called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests and said, "What will you give me if I betray him to you?" They paid him thirty pieces of silver. And from that moment he began to look for an opportunity to betray him. Matthew 26:14-16 (NRSV)
Egg 3	Purple / Scarlet Fabric	They stripped him and put a scarlet robe on him Matthew 27:28 (NRSV)
Egg 4	Thorns	and after twisting some thorns into a crown, they put it on his head. They put a reed in his right hand and knelt before him and mocked him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews!" Matthew 27:29 (NRSV)
Egg 5	Twine	So Pilate, wishing to satisfy the crowd, released Barabbas for them; and after flogging Jesus, he handed him over to be crucified. Mark 15:15 (NRSV)
Egg 6	Cross	So they took Jesus; 17 and carrying the cross by himself, he went out to what is called The Place of the Skull, which in Hebrew is called Golgotha. John 19:16-17 (NRSV)
Egg 7	Nail	There they crucified him, and with him two others, one on either side, with Jesus between them. John 19:18 (NRSV)
Egg 8	Sign (Below)	There was also an inscription over him, "This is the King of the Jews." Luke 23:38 (NRSV)
Egg 9	Vinegar Sponge	At once one of them ran and got a sponge, filled it with sour wine, put it on a stick, and gave it to him to drink. Matthew 27:48 (NRSV)
Egg 10	Rock	So Joseph took the body and wrapped it in a clean linen cloth and laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn in the rock. He then rolled a great stone to the door of the tomb and went away. Matthew 27:59-60 (NRSV)
Egg 11	Cloves	But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb, taking the spices that they had prepared. Luke 24:1 (NRSV)
Egg 12	EMPTY!	But the angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid; I know that you are looking for Jesus who was crucified. He is not here; for he has been raised, as he said. Come, see the place where he lay." Matthew 28:5-6 (NRSV)
