



The masters pathway

- Learn to row/scull
- Novice racing (1 year)
- Age group racing
- FAIL (or at least a long time delay)
- Some solutions bigger boats with tolerant athletes who are prepared to race with less experienced
- The learning journey is not smooth and "jumping up" masks learning and achievement at intermediate stages

- New Masters racing (2-5 years)
- Age group racing

What's needed to succeed

- Federations to recognise this status
- Regattas to offer events
- Clubs to continue Learn To Row classes
