Read the Bible passage for the day one time slowly, soaking in each phrase. Read again if time allows.

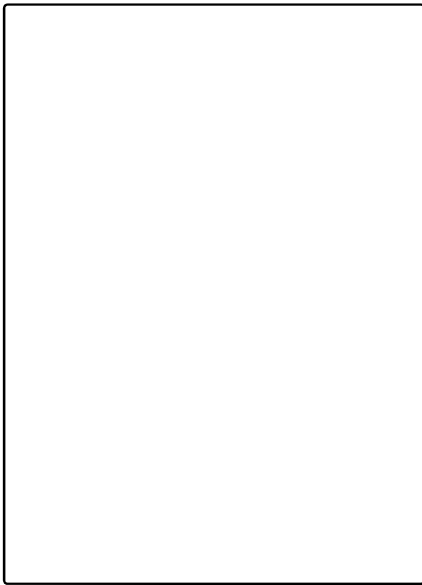

Psalms 29:11


